

Grassington to River Wharfe Route: For Some



Grassington to River Wharfe

Route type: For some. This 1.7km circular route follows the River Wharfe from Grassington – OS Explorer Map OL2

Distance: 1.7km

Start point: SE002637

Facilities: The nearest public toilets, including RADAR facility toilets, are in the Grassington National Park car park. There are public parking facilities – including five designated bays for blue badge holders - in the Grassington National Park car park.

Getting there: Car: From Skipton take the B6265 towards Grassington. Turn right at Threshfield and follow the road into Grassington. The road bears to the right with the car park on the right-hand side.

The Route

A gate at the lower end of the car park gives access to a walled lane. The route here is well-surfaced with some gradients reaching a 1:7. Follow the river to the right along an unsurfaced route. From here, turn right onto the main road into Grassington where the first 50m are a 1:6 gradient.

Take a moment to look at Linton Falls when by the river. The falls mark the line of the North Craven Fault.
